Terms of payment

In accordance with the provisions of article 7 of the Standard Terms and Conditions of Event Participation, the Registration Fee will be invoiced immediately after the confirmation of participation. The Participation costs (stand hire and, if applicable, shell scheme stand construction), should be paid in two instalments, namely:

- 1st advance of 25% of the total number of square metres reserved: within 21 days of the date of the first advance invoice (advance invoices are sent from 365 days before the exhibition).
- 2nd advance of 100% (less the 25% of the first advance invoice): within 21 days of the date of the second advance invoice (these are sent from 60 days before the exhibition).

No advance invoices are sent from 60 days before the exhibition. In the event of application less than 60 days before the first build-up day of the exhibition the amount owed should be paid **in full** together with the application, but at least 4 days before the first build-up day.

All costs mentioned are excluding VAT.

Specific Terms and Conditions Aquatech China

The provisions subject to which exhibitors may take part in Aquatech China 2010 (hereinafter referred to as the exhibition) are laid down in these Specific Terms and Conditions and in the Standard Terms and Conditions of Event Participation (hereinafter called Standard Terms).

Organisation

The exhibition is organised by Amsterdam RAI B.V. (hereinafter and in the Standard Terms referred to as 'the organisers').

Venue and dates

The Exhibition will be held in the Shanghai Exhibition Center, 1000 Yan an Road, Shanghai 200040, P.R. China, from Wednesday 2 June up to and including Friday 4 June 2010.

Opening hours

The exhibition will be open to visitors from;

Wednesday 2 June	09:30 A.M. – 04:30 P.M.
Thursday 3 June	09:00 A.M. – 04:30 P.M.
Friday 4 June	09:00 A.M. – 03:00 P.M.

For exhibitors, the venue will be accessible from two hours before the opening until one hour after the closing of the exhibition.

Construction and dismantling period

The Shanghai Exhibition Center will be open for stand construction and preparation on Monday 31 May and Tuesday 1 June, 08.30 am to 05.00 pm.

The exhibits may be removed and the stands dismantled and taken away on Friday 4 June, from 3.00 pm.

Admission charge

There will be no basic admission charge as referred to in Clause 2 of the General Rules. Visitors who can show their business card can enter the Exhibition free of charge. Exhibitors can also obtain an unlimited number of tickets at administrative expenses and forwarding-charges for their customers and prospects.

Exhibition programme

Only goods and services may be exhibited at the Exhibition which – in the Organisers' opinion – are in line with the Exhibition's objective of providing visitors with as extensive as possible an overview of the current range of products and services in the field of Water Treatment, Transport & Storage, Point of Use and Process control technology & process automation from the Netherlands and abroad. All this being up to the Organisers' discretion or the Organisers appointed entry committee.

Demonstrations

Special activities at stands, such as product presentations, performances and shows, may only take place if written permission is granted by the organisers. Please note that permission must be requested in writing at the latest 30 days before the beginning of the construction period. This permission is subject to various conditions, including that the activity must be situated in such a way that interested visitors do not block the corridor.

Exhibitors

The goods and services described in the section 'Exhibition programme' may only be exhibited by companies which manufacture these materials and equipment, or propagate the processes and systems in question; or the sole representatives for China who have been appointed by foreign manufacturers of the items in question. Companies and institutions rendering services in the relevant sectors may also take part in the Exhibition, as well as other companies and institutions which the Organisers may admit in special cases.

Intellectual Property

No exhibitor may display any product or display or distribute any advertisements for a product that infringes upon the registered trademark, copyright, or patent of another company. The exhibitor will be obliged to sign the Non-Copy declaration which will be sent to the exhibitor together with the confirmation of stand space. The Exhibitor agrees to defend, at Exhibitor's expense, and to indemnify the Organisers for any action brought against the Organisers arising out of any dispute concerning Exhibitor's infringement upon the intellectual property of another.

Hire of stand space

Exclusive Zone: at EUR 250.00 per m² (EUR 225.00 when booked before 1 December, 2009)

Premium Zone: minimum of 12m² at EUR 231.00 per m² (EUR 208.00 when booked before 1 December, 2009)

Deluxe Zone: minimum of 12m² at EUR 173.00 per m² (EUR 156.00 when booked before 1 December, 2009)

The registration fee is € 210.00 excluding VAT and is non-refundable. For terms of payment we refer to the registration form and please see hereunder. Cancellations are covered by the relevant section of the Standard Terms. The registration fee invoice will be sent to the exhibitors immediately upon receipt of their application form.

Shell scheme construction

Exhibitors who do not wish to construct their own stand may order a shell scheme booth package, thus saving labour and costs of transport etc.

We offer 2 different types of shell scheme construction: Premium and Deluxe. For prices and all further information please refer to the application form of Aquatech China 2010.

Management fee for Space only exhibits

The participant with own stand construction has to pay a construction management fee to the Shanghai Exhibition Center upon arrival during the build up period of RMB 30.00 per sq.m. for domestic exhibitors and RMB 60.00 per sq.m. for international exhibitors.

Terms of payment

Stand rental, plus the appropriate tax(if applicable), shall be paid in two instalments, deviating from the provision laid down in Clause 5 of the General Rules.

1. Registration fee directly after receiving confirmation of participation.
 2. 25% of the number of square metres applied for, within 21 days of the date of the first advance invoice.
 3. 75% (the balance) within 21 days of the date on the final invoice(confirming the allocation of stand space).
- If applications are made less than 30 days before the first day of construction of the Exhibition the stand rent due, shall have been received by the Organisers by return of mail but not later than before the first day of construction of the Exhibition.

Disputes

Any complaints should be made within 30 days of the last day of the exhibition. Complaints brought to our attention beyond this deadline will not be addressed.

Application for stand space

- An applicant / participant (hereinafter referred to as '**Participant**') declares, by means of a fully completed application form submitted to the organisers, that he/she is in agreement with the conditions of participation in force for the fair, exhibition and other event (hereinafter referred to as '**the Exhibition**') contained in the relevant '**Conditions of Participation**' (the entirety of the Standard Terms and Conditions, the Specific Terms and Conditions and the Standing Rules).
- No right to allocation of stand space may be derived from the application. In special cases the organisers may decide not to process an application, to allocate less stand space than has been applied for, to alter allocated stand space or to withdraw an existing allocation without the Participant being entitled to claim compensation for damage incurred.
- The information requested on the application form must be provided in full. Without being liable to pay any compensation, the organisers have the right to refuse any goods or services which have not been mentioned on the application form or which they consider inadmissible by virtue of the Conditions of Participation, or to have such goods or services removed from the Exhibition forthwith.

Cancellations

- The organisers reserve the right at all times to change the dates of the Exhibition or to cancel the Exhibition altogether in the event of circumstances beyond their control (force majeure), without a Participant having the right to claim compensation for any damage.
- No application may be cancelled or altered unilaterally by the Participant. The organisers may grant a request to cancel or alter an application subject, among other things, to the condition that the Participant concerned pays a cancellation fee. This fee amounts, at least, to:
 - upon cancellation more than 365 days before the first exhibition build-up day: 15% of the Participation Costs;
 - upon cancellation in the period from 365 to 183 days before the first exhibition build-up day: 50% of the Participation Costs;
 - upon cancellation in the period from 182 to 63 days before the first exhibition build-up day: 75% of the Participation Costs;
 - upon cancellation in the period from 62 to 32 days before the first exhibition build-up day: 100% of the Participation Costs;
 - upon cancellation in the period up to and including 31 days before the first exhibition build-up day: 120% of the Participation Costs.
- Participation Costs are the costs payable by the Participant to the organisers for the stand hire and, if applicable, the stand build-up, plus the VAT due.
- In the case of cancellation for whatever reason, the Participant will always forfeit his/her application fee, plus the VAT due.

Stand hire and payment obligations

- Unless otherwise stipulated in the Conditions of Participation, payment must be made as follows:
 1. the application fee before or on the due date of the invoice in question;
 2. the Participation Costs in 2 instalments:
 - 25% of the Participation Costs;
 - 100% of the Participation Costs minus the above-mentioned 25%; before or on the due date of the invoices in question.
- If the Participant does not meet his/her financial obligations, the organisers will be entitled not to proceed with the allocation of stand space, or to withdraw an existing allocation of stand space or not to make stand space available, without prejudice to the organisers' claim for full payment of the amounts due.
- The organisers are entitled to contract out the collection of the amounts owed by the Participant, in which case all costs will be borne by the Participant, plus the statutory interest and extrajudicial costs of collection amounting to 150% of the principal.

Liability

- Goods present in the Exhibition Building or its grounds are for the account and risk of the Participant. The organisers do not undertake the insurance of the goods. The organisers are not liable for any damage or injury from whatever cause to goods or persons caused by or connected with participation in the Exhibition, unless there has been intent or gross negligence on the part of the organisers. Nor can the organisers be held liable for damage to third parties caused by the use of the stand by the Participant or his/her staff or by persons working on the instructions of the Participant. The Participant shall indemnify the organisers against all claims by third parties on this account.
- The Participant is liable for and must take out adequate insurance against any damage caused in any way whatever by acts or omissions on his/her part or on the part of his/her staff or persons working for him/her or on his/her instructions or caused by his/her exhibits or goods. The Participant shall indemnify the organisers against all claims for which they may be held liable by third parties.

Final provisions

The organisers may, without giving notice of default and without recourse to the courts, take one or more of the following measures against a Participant who breaches any provision of the Conditions of Participation or fails to comply with a direction given by or on behalf of the organisers (such measures being taken at the expense of the Participant):

- refuse the person(s) concerned admission to the Exhibition and/or the Exhibition Building with immediate effect;
- have his/her stand closed and/or cleared;
- keep possession of the goods displayed and of anything constructed or installed by the Participant;

without the Participant being entitled to enforce any right to restitution or reparation.
